SCHOLARSHIP GENERAL RULES

1. To be eligible for the HPJPHC's Scholarship, the following requirements must be met.
 - a. Current Graduating High School Senior
 - b. Active HPJPHC member for at least one year
 - c. Scholastic Average Ranking in the upper one-half of the class
 - d. Applied for admittance to an accredited college, university, vocational, or trade school.

2. The following items must be submitted to the HPJPHC Youth Advisor by May 20th.
 - a. Completed application (Must be typed).
 - b. Copy of High School transcript
 - c. Three letters of reference in sealed envelopes written by members of each of the following: School, Community, HPPHC

The youth advisor will screen all applications to see that all requirements are met. A committee, appointed by the President of the HPPHC, will then review the completed applications and select a winner to receive the scholarship. Notification will be made by May 15th.
